First outdoor scramble is coming up April 8... a SATURDAY!


Now is a good time to lube everything needing lubing and doing some home ground school. Make sure all of your CLG launchers have fresh rubber and well as your winderuppers.


That is it for now. See you on the field the 8<sup>th</sup> of April and then for the Round Valley indoor contest in the dome's 100 foot ceiling.

## The Viability of an organization... JMHO – Rick Pangell

#### In terms of Business Schools:

The viability of a business is measured by its long-term survival and its ability to sustain profits over a period of time.

A business is able to survive when it's viable because it continues to make a profit year after year. The longer a company can stay profitable, the better its viability.

A business demonstrates its viability by making a profit every year of its existence. Some say a viable business is one "with legs," and the Cambridge Dictionary says something with legs can continue to exist and be successful for a long time.

Viability is like trust. When your trust in someone is shaken, it's almost impossible to get it back. And, when a business loses its profitability, that's difficult to recover from. So viability is linked to profit, but also to both solvency and liquidity.

#### How Is Viability Different from Solvency?

Business viability is often confused with two other terms that are often used for business performance – solvency and liquidity. A business is solvent when it has enough assets to cover its liabilities.

## How does that apply to the MMM Club, a non-profit?

The MMM Club is for all intent and purpose, a business model. This makes a lot of sense if you consider we do not have a hard product like a toaster to sell, but we offer Free Flight, something less tangible.

And, it is solvent. This is fortunate in that our leadership manages our club monies well, not that we are "rich," but we spend and fund our activities appropriately. Monies coming in are at least equal or more than our expenses. Our expenses are the field lease and our two major contests; the FAI Annual and the Rocky Mountain Champs.

## Our "viability" comes from our membership. Yup, dues paying members.

What that means is we need to have an active membership. The MMM Club sponsors many activities. The AMA, NFFS, FAI, SAM, FAC and of course FF in general. The MMM club provides a huge opportunity for free flight in general, whether Outdoor, Indoor, support of school programs like Science Olympiad, Technology Student Association, and STEM. We have been blessed with so many of our members supporting those activities with both their resources and their time.

I guess if I had to state one thing that irritates me is people who do not want to help us out but want what we provide. When I am on the field and pulse flyers if they are interested in supporting this activity, they may say ... "I don't want to join because of... yadda yadda." My usual response is... "Where do you think this field and opportunity comes from?" Why does one have the privilege of standing here flying you models? Others have spent time and effort so you can have this opportunity. Do you think you can help? Support what gives you opportunity.

I fall back on the notion that too many folks think that everything should be free... the internet, online experiences, twitter, facebook, and all that. What they do not realize is they pay for all that experience as soon as they sign up and pay for internet and phone and all that. They have inherently sold all of their personal info and paid for someone to take it. So why do they not want to help out something that they actually get something for? Odd

## **Another point of View... from Chuck**

Another aspect of club viability is volunteering. As with any club, some members give little, or no, thought to how things get done. Perhaps to them, our big contests, outreach efforts, site acquisition/retention, etc. just sort of magically happen. It is paramount to the viability of any club that the work is shared among the members and not just left to a few. I have seen clubs (non-modeling) die when the leaders got burned out and no one was willing to step up and replace them. Providing support for the club and its leaders is a key to club viability and the avoidance of burnout. Perhaps some feel that the people doing the work just WANT to do it and maybe they don't have a life. I have actually heard people say, "I don't want to be involved, I just want to fly." Guess what? So do those who make the club work but they also recognize that the flying opportunities, venues and organization are the result of the efforts that keep the club healthy.

With that said, the MMM club is already great BECAUSE so many members share the load. The club purposefully cultivates a culture best described by Art Hillis, "Many hands make light work." As great as the MMM club is, imagine what it could be if EVERY able bodied member contributed at least a little time and effort? Not sure what needs to be done? Just ask any of the club leaders.
