

MMM Monthly Scramble Nov 5 2017 Contest Report

The weather forecast for the day held true. Temperatures ranged from 42°F to 55°F. Initially the wind was from the SSW but rotated to come from the ESE before much flying was done. Wind was always present with an average speed of 10 MPH throughout the day. In combination the conditions were cold, but a good show was put on by some of the Club's best fliers and competitors.

In advance of the contest The Max-Out reported a 2 point spread between Ray Boyd and Don DeLoach for the Season Scramble Championship. Ray was leading going into the day. He maintained his position through two maxes with his OT Rubber model, but dropped his third flight. Don started flying after Ray and was playing catchup. It came down to Don's third flight with his E-36 model. His max on this flight appears to have secured both the Monthly and Season Scramble Championships for Don, but this is to be confirmed by the Official Scorer.

While the season battle was playing out, the glider guys were putting up long flights followed by longer chases. Mark Covington's second max required an extended period to recover. Unfortunately, much of the good air had gone by the time he was ready for his last three official flights. He was not able to force Don into additional flights to determine the winner of the Monthly Scramble.

The day was made even more enjoyable by the Frito Pie feast at noon hosted by Jerry and Don along with a concert performance by Rosen the Bow. Somehow Ray Boyd is able to convince them to come out to the field to play for us. We appreciate your salesmanship Ray! Along with their usual repertoire of Irish folk music, we were treated to a rendition of the MMM Theme Song, Jerry Jeff Walker's Pissin' in the Wind. To make it even better they added some verses that focus on the
